#### VCSE commitments

- To set priorities for representation and appoint reps with a mandate to speak for the sector
- To set our own shared strategic priorities and lead on these
- To collaborate within the VCSE sector
- To support community engagement
- To create volunteering opportunities

#### ICS commitments

- To work with the pathways for engagement defined by the VCSE sector
- To welcome an ongoing dialogue at a senior strategic level
- To fund VCSE infrastructure
- To use proportionate commissioning processes that reflect full cost recovery
- To make better use of VCSE intelligence and data; to share ICS data where possible
- To recognise the right of the VCSE sector to challenge and campaign without impact on the funding relationship with the ICS

Develop VCSE structure for engagement supported by a reimbursement policy


A co-developed social value policy and a review of commissioning processes
